Chevron Shliach Danny Cohen went to visit incarcerated Yitzchok Pass, for the purpose of checking his Tefillin, in response to a request by Pass' father.

When Cohen met the guards, he explained that he was Pass' Rabbi. The guards agreed to fetch Pass' Tefillin and to deliver the extra pair that Cohen brought along, for Pass to use until the ones being checked were returned. Cohen told the guards he would really like to meet with Pass, but was told that would be against the rules.

The guards began checking what Cohen had brought for Pass, and saw a book of stories of the Rebbe. The guards got very excited about the book. They gazed at the picture of the Rebbe on the cover and miraculously 'the rules' changed. The guards escorted Pass to Cohen, so they were able to meet and talk.

Yitzchok Pass is the father of Shalhevet, the 10 month old baby, who was murdered after the government withdrew the IDF from the hills overlooking the Jewish community of Chevron. Pass was wounded in the leg, in the same attack. Not only is he a victim of Arab terror, he is a victim of the effort by the GSS to harass settlers and blacken their reputation.
